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

After Christmas, starting on Thursday 10th January, the Year 6 children from Greenhead School will be transported for one morning per week to Henshaw to work with the Year 6 children there, taking part in creative writing, SPaG and maths sessions as a larger cohort. We feel that this will be extremely beneficial for them to work together as a larger group on different tasks, which will include work around SAT's papers to prepare them for their SAT's test in May.

School Visit

Recently we had a visit from our School Improvement Officer, Mr David Shearsmith, and we are delighted to be able to share the following points with you:

"Pupils' personal development has improved overall with pupils' attitudes to learning improving, particularly where teaching has been consistently good."

"The Early Years is a strength of the school due to good quality provision and consistently good teaching over time so that children perform well"

"Transition from the private Nursery into the school is a growing strength, with the school working more closely with the Nursery to ensure children have a good start to their time in school"

"Most pupils generally made good progress across the school due to the school tracking pupils' progress effectively and intervening where pupils were likely to underachieve"

"The school's wider curriculum is improving with progress picking up in the foundation subjects as the school embeds it and develops its assessment systems to ensure all pupils are making good progress"
