Learning Achievements

- **Class 1** This week we have been learning about teeth health and how to keep our teeth healthy. In maths we have been exploring 9 and 10. We enjoyed a fantastic World Book Day. The children's outfits were amazing! The children did some super writing about the character they came as and why they love that character. We read lots of new stories throughout the day, made Gruffalo cupcakes and made our own book marks. We have introduced our new topic of Dinosaurs and have thought about what we already know and what we would like to find out.
- Class 2 We have had a very busy first week back including, NUFC, Swimming and Commando Joes. We have also been listening to the story 'Topsy and Tim Visit London' and writing our own version of the story using a story map to help us. In Maths, Year 1 have been comparing numbers within 50 and Year 2 have practising division. We enjoyed World Book day, talking about and sharing stories. In RE we have acted out the Easter story and made pancakes to celebrate Shrove Tuesday.
- Class 3 This week we have been looking at the elements of story writing in English and have begun to do some fantastic storytelling. The class has such great imagination. In Maths, we have been looking at fractions on number lines, fractions of shapes and fractions of amounts. On Friday, we had chocolate to share! In topic, we have been doing work on earthquakes and have begun to create buildings to try out on our 'shake table' taking of the things that designers do to help make building earthquake-proof. We have begun our work with Commando Joe again and in PHSE, we have been looking at what keeps us healthy.
- **Class 4** This week in English, the children have been looking at different persuasive features. In Maths, Year 5 children have been adding and subtracting fractions. Year 6 children have been forming equations in algebra. In Science, the children have been looking at line graphs showing the typical range of heights and growth patterns of males and females. As a class we decided to create our own growth chart to represent the different heights. In Music, we listened to our song for this term as our topic is 'The Fresh Prince of Bel Air'.

In RE, the children used their acting skills and knowledge of the Easter story to freeze frame different parts of the story. On Thursday, we all loved dressing up as a book character/PJs and discussing our favourite books.

They have also been given a World Book Day £1 Book token, which they can take to their local bookshop to get a free World Book Day book, or £1 off any book worth £2.99 or more.


