Learning Achievements

Class 1 – This week we have been looking at our new topic 'What's that sound?' and have been on a sound walk around the school grounds. In Maths, our Reception children have been exploring 2D shapes and Year 1 have been looking at Place value. In RE, we enjoyed the Ash Wednesday Service in All Hallow's Church.

Class 2 – We have started our new topic 'Muck, Mess & Mixture'. We have listened to the story 'George's Marvellous Medicine' and took on the role of George and created our own magic medicines!

Class 3 — Class 3 have been completing the 500 word challenge. We listened to some of the top 50 stories on the BBC 500 word website and then planned, drafted, edited and published our own. It was a difficult challenge, but WE DID IT! The children have started their new topic 'Tomorrow's World'.
