First, they will look at some pictures of a koala, describe what its position is, and complete a short task filling in the missing prepositions of place. Then, children will identify when we use the prepositions 'at' 'in' and 'on' in relation to time and see if they can spot a rule. They will identify the two main clauses, the verbs and the coordinating conjunctions in compound sentences.
