## Learning Achievements

Class 1 - This week we have continued to enjoy the story of 'Mr Gumpy's Outing'. We created Mr Gumpy's boat from a huge box so that we could play in it. The boat turned into an aeroplane later in the week whilst we were playing in our 'Travel Agents' role play area. In Maths we have been looking at positional language. We enjoyed a local walk on Thursday and did a vehicle survey. We saw eight different types of vehicles. We learnt about road safety before we went out. We had great fun raising some money for Children in Need and we loved looking at each other's spotty outfits! We did lots of great activities including watching a story to explain what Children in Need is, making Pudsey masks, doing yoga with Pudsey, doing PE with Joe Wicks and decorating Pudsey biscuits.

Class 2 - This week we have been reading the book 'Katie in London' and discussing some of the landmarks in London. In Maths, Year 1 have been practising subtraction and counting back on the number line; Year 2 have been subtracting two digit numbers. In Science, we have explored the properties of materials and discussed the uses of different materials.

Class 3-In Class 3 we have been studying labels on bottles of everyday materials. We then designed and made our own label for Alice's 'Drink Me' bottle- warning of the dangers. In Maths, we have been working on estimation, near numbers and using the inverse. In forest schools, we created some tree faces for our winter trees and in Science we have been looking at liquids and their viscosity. In PSHE, we have been thinking about what makes a family and the responsibilities of family units. We have continued with our class texts this week of 'Alice in Wonderland 'and 'The Witches'.

Class 4 - This week we have been developing our understanding of the different art movements, focusing especially on Impressionism. We have had another 'gallery trip' to view some of the most famous Impressionist paintings and discussed our favourite paintings and artists as a class. We then used this to write a short narrative based upon our favourite Impressionist painting. In Maths, we have been using our 'Flashback 4' to challenge our learning, fractions and factors this week. In forest school, we enjoyed the experience of painting outside.
