### **Governor News**

Everyone at Henshaw School feels a great sense of privilege to be serving the communities of Henshaw, Bardon Mill, Thorngrafton and beyond. So it's good to having this chance to share with you some of the good news about Henshaw School - YOUR community school.

The last five years have seen the school grow in numbers by about 50%. There are now 60 children on roll divided into three classes - Reception, Year1 and 2, and Years 3 to 6. We share the school buildings with Henshaw Nursery, which is also a thriving place, just about full and recently graded 'Outstanding' by OFSTED. The two organisations work really well together. Henshaw School was graded 'Good' in an OFSTED Inspection just about one year ago.

Because the school has grown - and is still growing, along with the Nursery - we need more space. So, in the New Year, work will start on a new classroom, built onto the front of the school, to the left of the path to the main door. The classroom will house the older children - Years 5 and 6 - and will be equipped to serve their needs in a new and particular way.

Thank you all very much for your support in 2018. We know that 2019 will just be as busy and exciting for the young people in our schools!
