Learning Achievements

Class 1 - This week we have been continuing to explore the story 'Handa's Surprise' and have been learning about Africa. The children made some fantastic story maps. We have also started to weave our own baskets like the one Handa has. We have been learning about the animals that live in Africa and have created our own safari parks and have used non-fiction books to help us write about the animals. We have created some fantastic African sunset safari paintings. We have been listening to and dancing to African music. In Maths we have been looking at doubling again. We have been tending to our plants and have moved our seedlings outside. Our sunflowers are starting to grow, which is very exciting!

Class 2 – We all thoroughly enjoyed Sports Day this week. In English, we have made a minibeast guidebook. In Maths, Year 1 has been looking at position and direction, whilst Year 2 has continued grouping and sharing. In Science, we have made habitats and explained why the minibeasts like those habitats. We have enjoyed another busy week!

Class 3 - This week, we have been working on tying up the loose ends from our theme 'Tremors'. It has been a fantastic theme. The children were able to recall so many of the facts this week, as we prepare a powerpoint about our learning in our English. In Year 3 science, we have been watching shadow puppet masters and created our own shadow screen for children to try out. The children also made their own circuits with bulb, light, cell and switch or motor. In Year 4 science, the children have listened to and created soundwaves using plastic piping, water and a tuning fork. In maths, we have been learning about lines and angles. In music, we have completed our musical composition of a volcano. It has been a really 'active' hands-on week enjoyed by all.

Class 4 — Class 4 has been very busy this week! The children have had a Tudor banquet to finish our topic and have been rewriting history! The children participated in a Tudor court hearing for Anne Boleyn after being accused of adultery, treason and witchcraft. Our prosecution and defence teams stated their arguments and pleas. It was decided unanimously by the jury that Anne was not guilty and would not be beheaded! In Maths, Year 5 have finished their unit of properties of shape; Year 6 have been using their knowledge of angles to work out other missing angles. Class 4 have also been recapping their colours in French.
