Learning Achievements

- **Class 1 -** We have been busy this week writing Christmas cards. We have also started making our Christmas crafts and some of us created some beautiful natural decorations during Forest school. We have been exploring 2D shapes in Maths and have been creating shape pictures in the style of Kadinsky. We have played 'guess the shape' and have been using mathematical language to create clues. In RE, we have continued to look at the story of the Nativity and have created our own nativity scene and labelled it.
- **Class 2** We have been writing letters this week in English. In Science we have investigated our sense of sight. We also carried out a blindfold challenge in Commando Joes. We have also enjoyed some Christmas Craft activities as well as practising the songs for our Christmas service.
- Class 3 In Class 3 this week, we have been getting ready for Christmas. We have made Christmas cards, large 3D angels for the church and have started to plan our party. In English, we have started to do our work on report writing to complete our theme and have done our reading quiz.
